Total of 20 students were selected for this workshop of which 17 were from India including three of them from Sikkim University, one from Thailand, one from Korea and one from Sri Lanka. The main purpose of this workshop was to train research scholars on the use of various imaging techniques. The workshop also included poster presentation competition which was held on the second half of the first day of workshop.

All the students were given hands on training on laboratory courses such as basic training in microscopy, laser scanning microscopy, super resolution microscopy, FCS analysis, electron microscopy, highthroughput screening and cell imaging based on bioluminescence technology, confocal microscopy, phase contrast microscopy, DIC and brain section and imaging of neuron morphology.
